	<p>Substance abuse services shall be provided only by a duly licensed professional within their scope of practice, or by an individual who is a licensed, certified, or registered substance abuse counselor through the North Carolina Substance Abuse Professional Practice Board, and who practices and is supervised in accordance with G.S. 90-113.32, Article 5C, the North Carolina Substance Abuse Professional Practice Act.</p> <p>NC-TOPPS Interviews are required of providers for all substance abuse target population adults and children ages 6 years and above who are receiving any qualifying service, including outpatient only services, for any substance abuse diagnosis.</p> <p>The client's service record shall include the federal substance abuse National Outcomes Measures (NOMs) and Treatment Episode Data Set (TEDS) admission and episode completion (discharge) data elements that are required to be reported by the Local Management Entity to the</p> <p>Division for the Consumer Data Warehouse (CDW). These elements include, but are not limited to, the identification at consumer admission and episode completion (discharge) of the consumer's primary, secondary, and tertiary substance problems, frequency of use, usual route of administration, age of first use, pregnancy status, living arrangements, employment status, arrest status, and social connectedness.</p>
